

RADIATION SAFETY PROGRAM UPDATES (May 2019)

TRAINING

Annual Radiation Safety Training Requirements:

Effective immediately, university personnel that handle radiation, will be required to complete an annual Radiation Safety Refresher course. This is in addition to the required initial safety training. The annual refresher course is necessary to ensure the safety of our lab personnel and for UCF to remain in compliance with policies and regulations. According to U.S. NRC 39.61 Subpart D, you are required to complete annual refresher training.

You should be receiving an email asking you to sign up for the training in the coming days. It will come from Webcourses and will state:

“You are currently more than six months overdue on completing your required safety training for EHS303: "Radiation Safety Annual Refresher for Radioactive Materials Users". Please contact EHS at EHSTraining@ucf.edu for instructions.”

RADIATION EXPOSURE REPORTS

Beginning March 1, 2019, all Occupational Radiation Exposure and Termination Reports must be requested through email.
